Community Solutions for Transportation Program

What Does This Program Have to Offer?

The Community Solutions for Transportation Program can provide:

- Assistance in finding child care which fits your needs
- Counseling and referrals regarding transportation options
- Up to \$15 a day round trip transportation costs per eligible family if needed, OR
- \$25 gas card per week
- Transportation costs are covered if the applicant is traveling from home to child care to work and back again.

*The Community Solutions for Transportation Program is a temporary assistance program. Each eligible applicant may remain in the program for a maximum of 6 months.

How Do I Qualify For The Program?

In order to qualify for the Community Solutions for Transportation Program, the applicant must meet the following eligibility requirements.

You Must:

- Be a parent residing in Rockland County.
- Be currently employed.
- Have a child currently enrolled in child care **or** be seeking enrollment in child care.
- Meet the eligibility guidelines below:

*Family Size	Income Eligible (Eligible if at or below)
2	\$29,140
3	\$36,620
4	\$44,100
5	\$51,580
6	\$59,060

*For larger families add \$7,480 for each additional family member
