Family Transportation Assistance Program



What Does This Program Have to Offer?

The Family Transportation Assistance Program can provide:

- Assistance in finding child care to fit your needs
- Counseling and referrals regarding transportation options
- \$15 a day round trip transportation costs per eligible family as needed
- Transportation costs are covered if the applicant is traveling from home to child care to work and back again



How Do I Qualify For The Program?

In order to qualify for the Family Transportation Assistance Program, the applicant must meet the following eligibility requirements.

You Must:

- Reside in Rockland County
- Be currently employed
- Not own a car
- Have a child currently enrolled in child care **or** be seeking enrollment in child care
- Meet the eligibility guidelines below:

*Family Size	Income Eligible (Eligible if at or below)
2	\$40,068
3	\$50,353
4	\$60,638
5	\$70,923
6*	\$81,218

*For larger families add \$10,275 for each additional family member
